The Odd Couple Characters

Oscar Madison - A carefree, good-natured, divorced sportswriter who lives alone in a messy eight-room New York apartment. He is completely oblivious to dirt, clutter, and the overdue child-support payments. He is an excessive gambler, careless spender but enjoys life. Not a homemaker! Able to play 40's-50's.

Felix Unger - A neurotic man who knows that he is difficult to live with but cannot—or will not—make any concessions or compromises. Fastidious, depressed and seems incapable of enjoying life. He is a compulsive cleaner, and a good cook. His wife asks him to leave the family despite his suicide threat. Friend Oscar invites Felix to move in with him. An odd couple! Able to play 40's-50's.

Gwendolyn & Cecily Pigeon - Oscar and Felix's giggly upstairs neighbors. A pair of English sisters. 2 scenes - Able to play 30's-50's.

Poker Players – Age range 40's up

Speed - Gruff and sarcastic, often picking on Vinnie and Murray.

Murray - A NYPD police officer.

Roy - Oscar's accountant. Roy has a dry wit but is less acerbic than Speed.

Vinnie - Vinnie is mild-mannered and henpecked, making him an easy target for Speed's verbal barbs.
